## 10 Didgeridoo

The Didgeridoo is usually made when a branch of a tree has been naturally hollowed out by nesting termites.

The Didgeridoo is traditionally played in ceremonies and is a male's playing instrument only


## What you need:



- Red paint
- Lunch wrap rolls or Plastic tubing
- Paints
- Cotton buds or thin sticks
- Paint brushes
- Egg carton to put the paint in



- Paint the lunch wrap roll or plastic tube brown and let dry.
- You can then paint the ends or the middle a different colour and let dry



Decorate the roll, using strips, or dots as shown in the picture



When completed, play some Aboriginal music and boys can blow into the Didgeridoo and the girls can partake by using tapping sticks.
