Designed to help you learn how to use the TYBE kit to run your own workshops on family violence, abuse and neglect and helping to keep children in your community safe.




The Through Young Black Eyes workshop kit was developed to help communities talk about family violence. The Kit focuses on the impacts on children of family violence and abuse.
