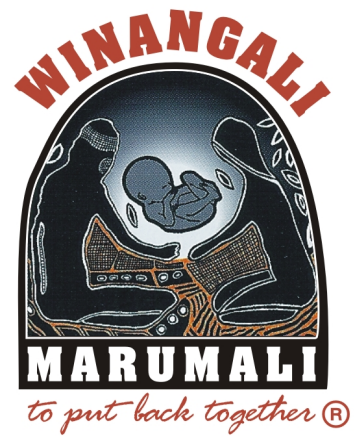


# Marumali Program
