This process was quite time consuming and demanding. SNAICC has since developed a resource which discusses DGR, the possible benefits and responsibilities that come with DGR status, the application process, tips to help make the process easier, and where to go for advice and support. It also briefly outlines some philanthropy and fundraising information.</p> <p>A hard copy of this resource was given to all Yarning Circle participants and is also available online. Notes on the updates to the DGR application process (which began operating in December 2012) will be available online on the SNAICC website and forwarded to participants once they are finalised.</p> <p>SNAICC encourages all participants to contact SNAICC with questions or feedback on the resource or the philanthropy and fundraising.</p>
