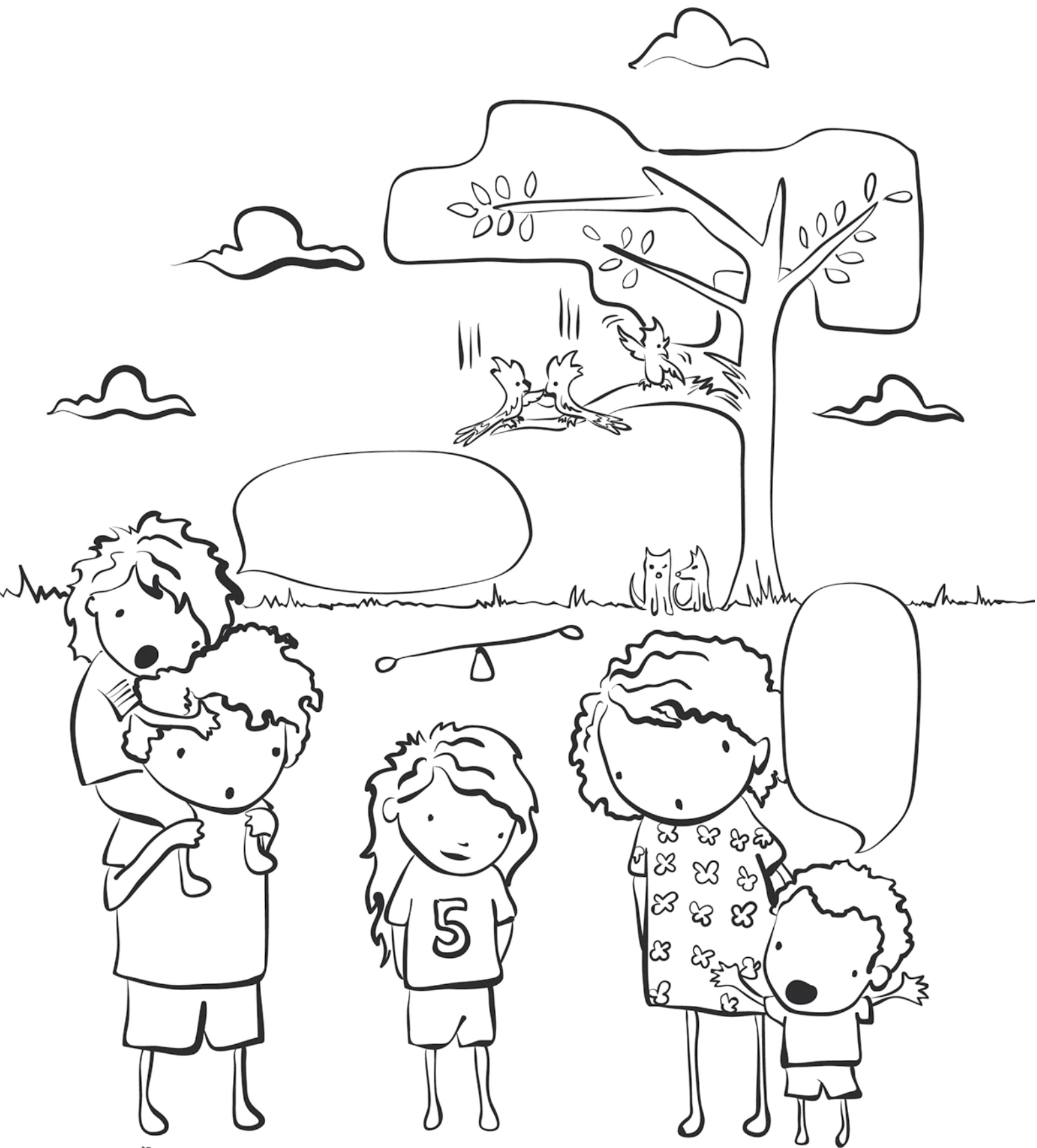
**Draw a picture of

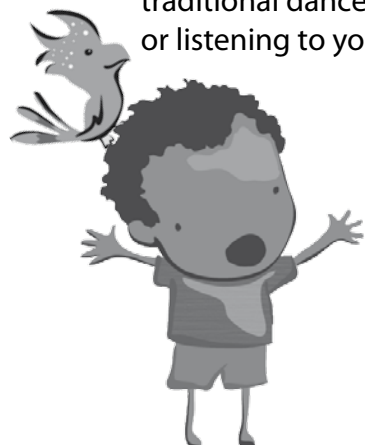
We have the right to be cared for and protected!
