Hand prints

Paint the child's hand using thick paint brushes. The top half of the hand is black and the bottom half including the thumb is red. Press the child's hand down in the middle of the sheet of paper. When lifted, place a yellow dot of paint in the middle.






Make a bracelet

- 1. Tie three strands together into a knot, leaving about 5 cm at the end
- 2. Secure the knot with sticky tape or under a clip of a clipboard
- 3. Separate the strands so there is one on the left, one in the middle, and one on the right.
- 4. Begin with the strand on the left. Use this strand to tie two knots onto the middle strand and continue on to the next strand over, and tie two knots on the right strand. The strand on the left has now moved across to the right.
- 5. Using the new strand that is on the left, tie two knots onto the middle strand and continue on to tie two knots on the right strand.

6. Continue to repeat this process.
