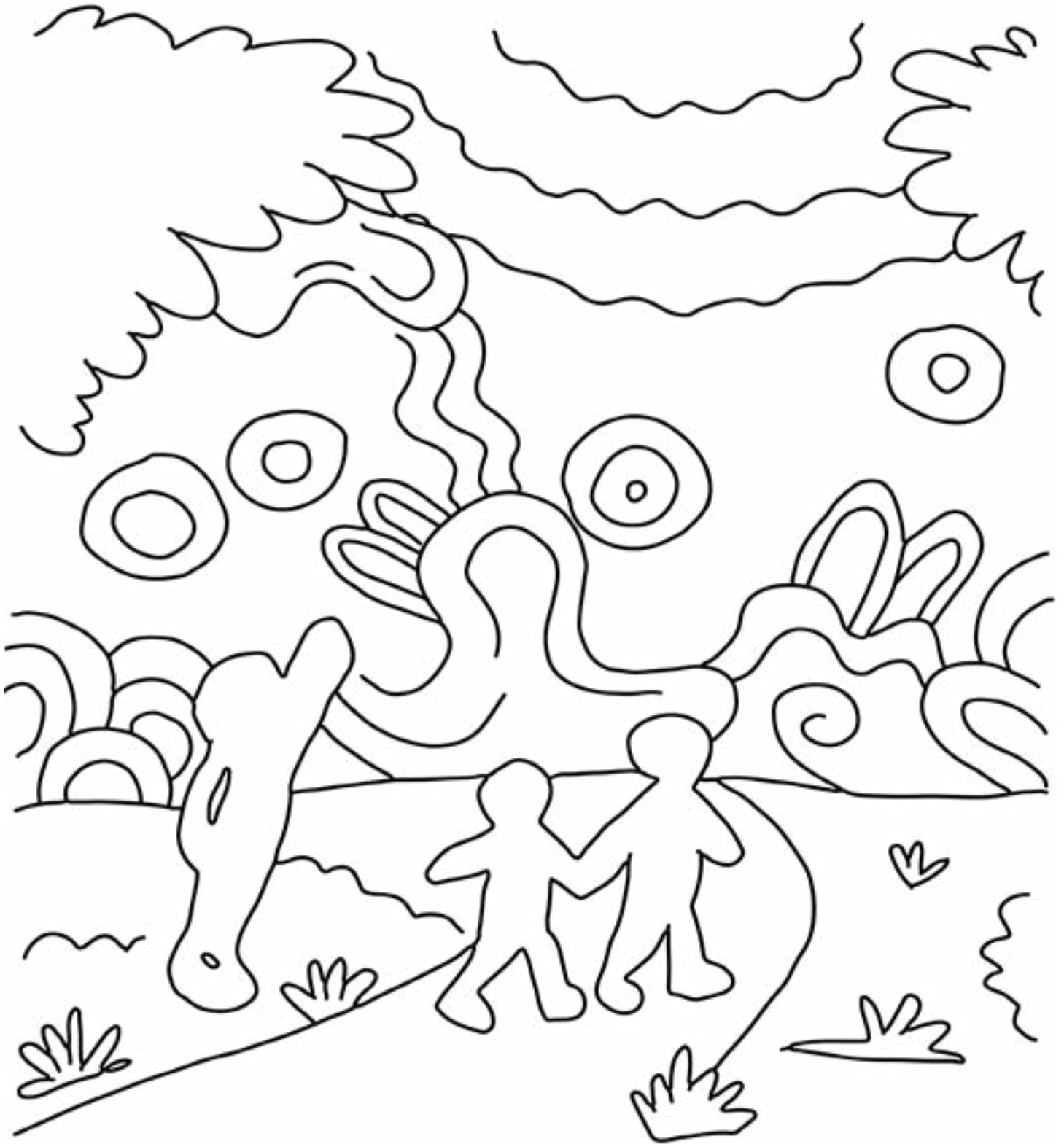

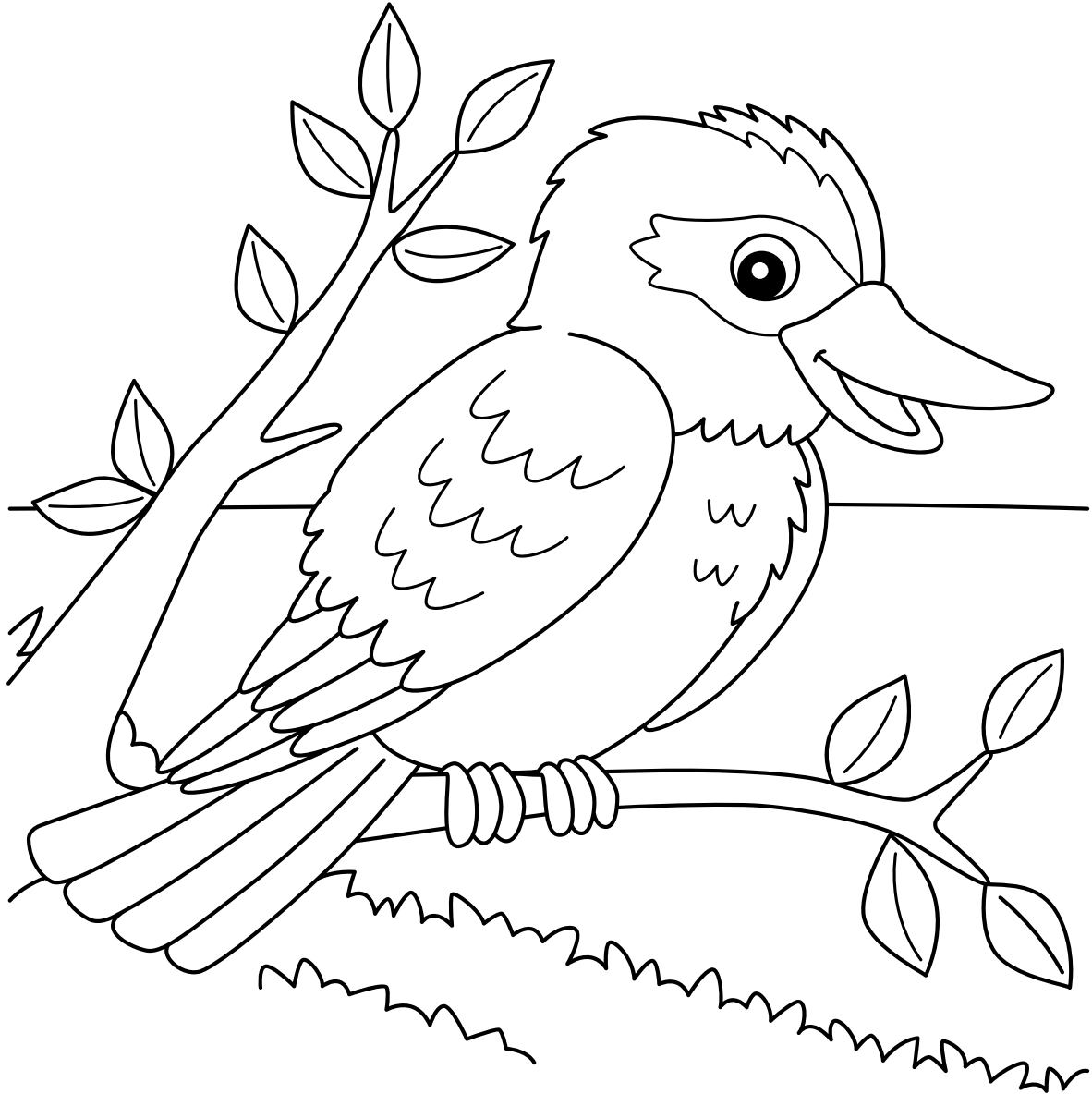

Don't forget to colour the sky and trees around it too!.

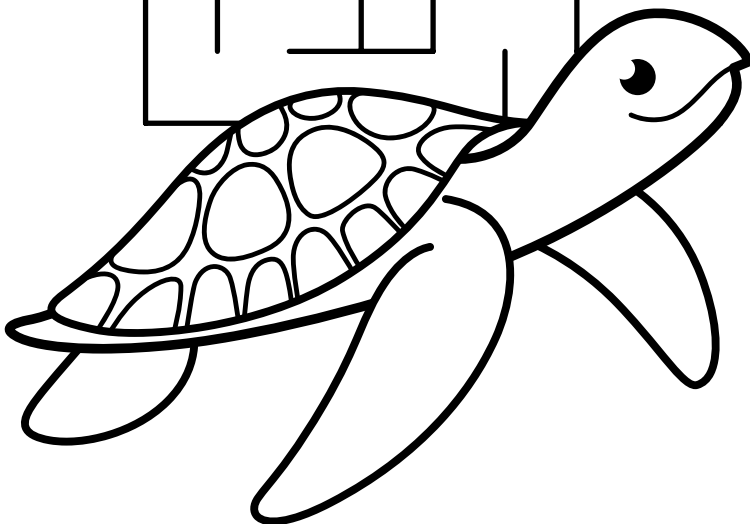
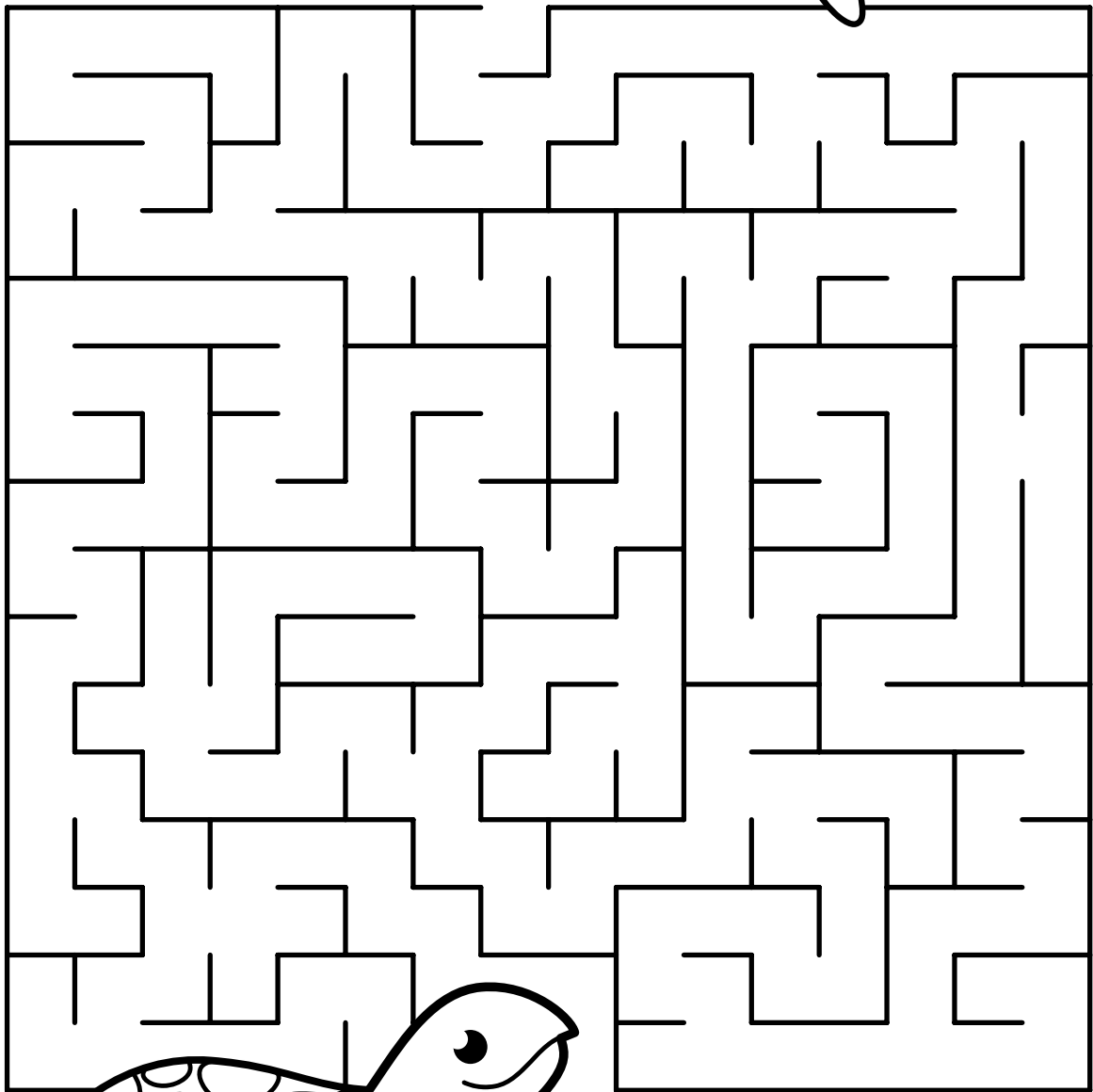
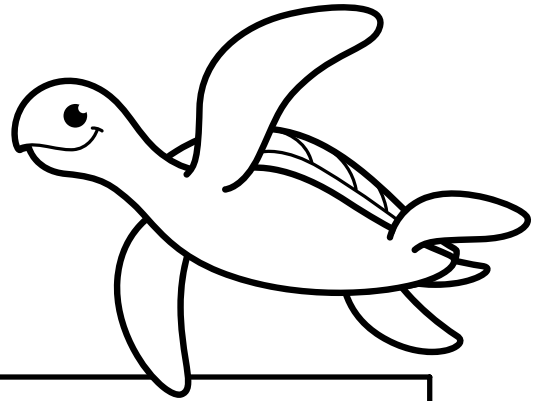


Did You Know?

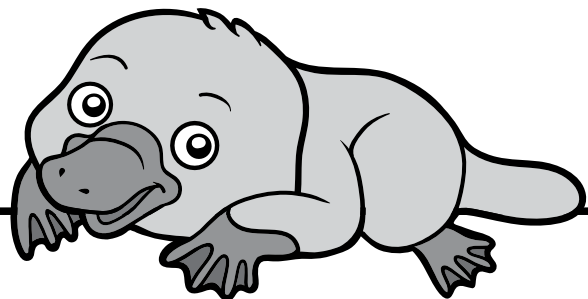
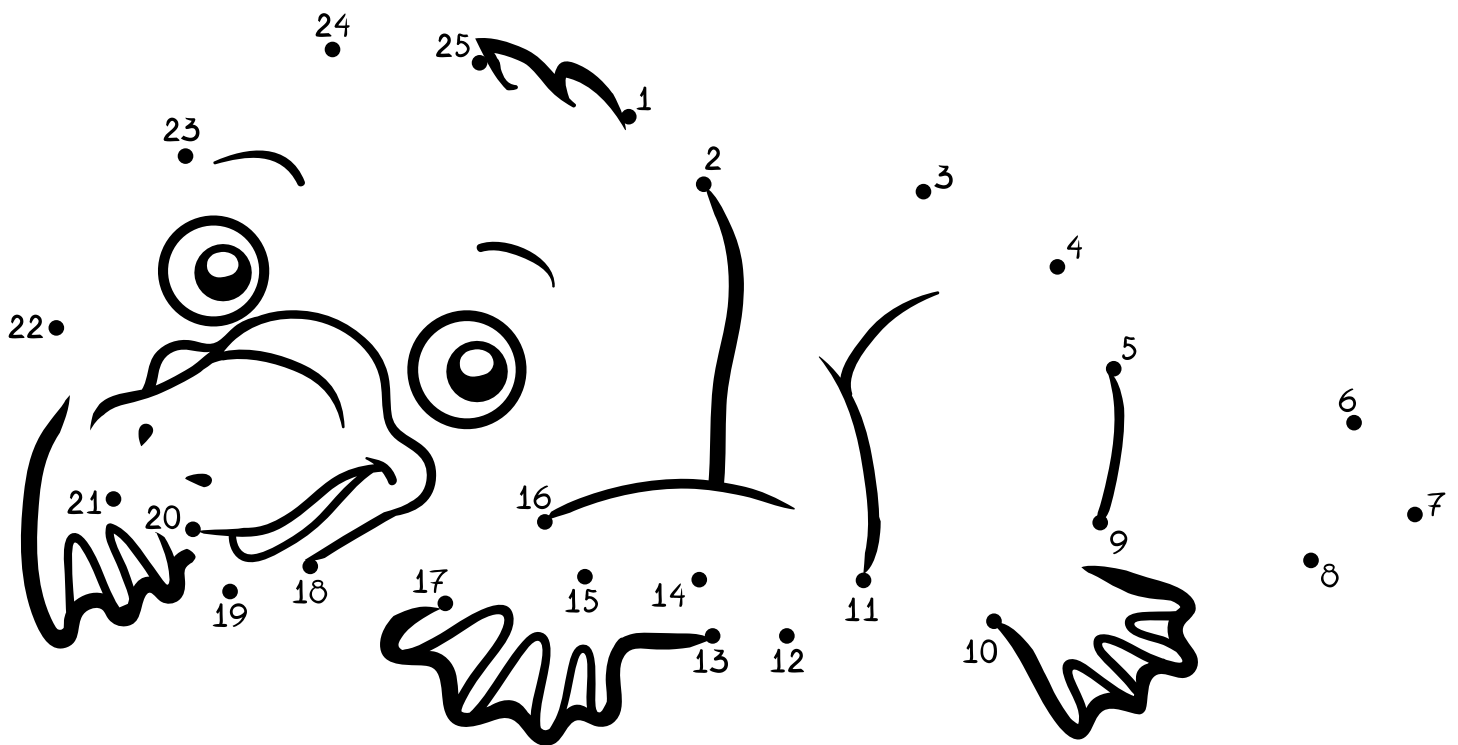
Turtles carry their homes on their backs — their shells!

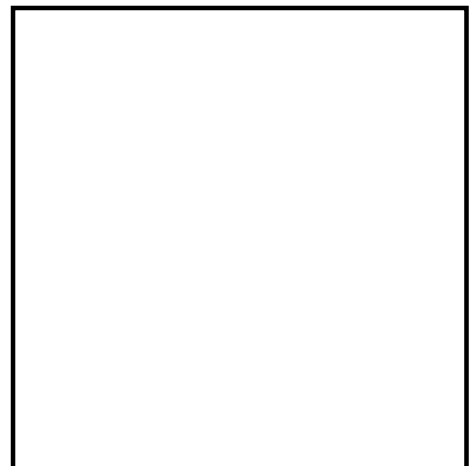
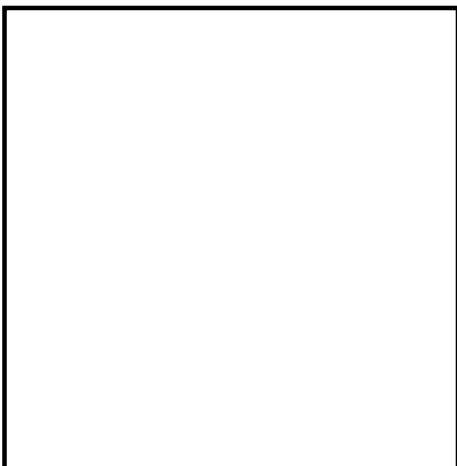
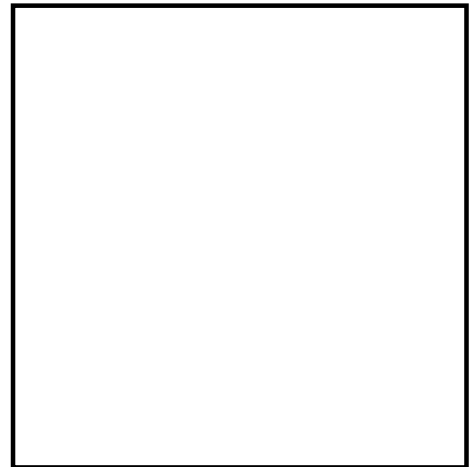
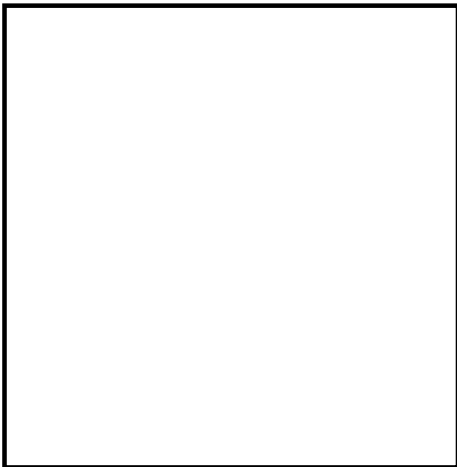
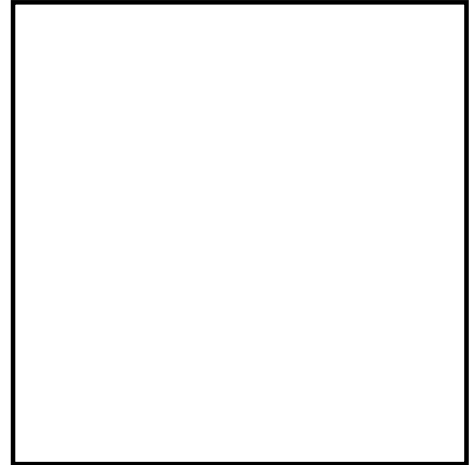
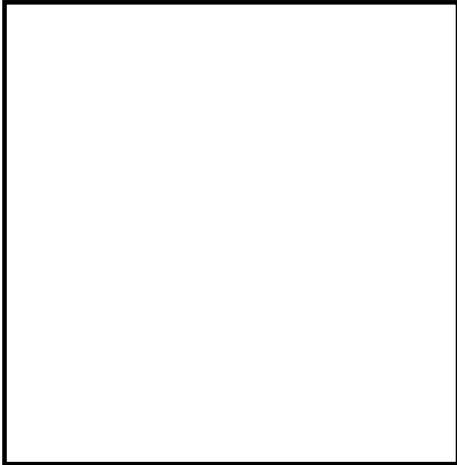
- A platypus lays eggs, even though it is a mammal!

Can you draw a line to connect each matching pair?

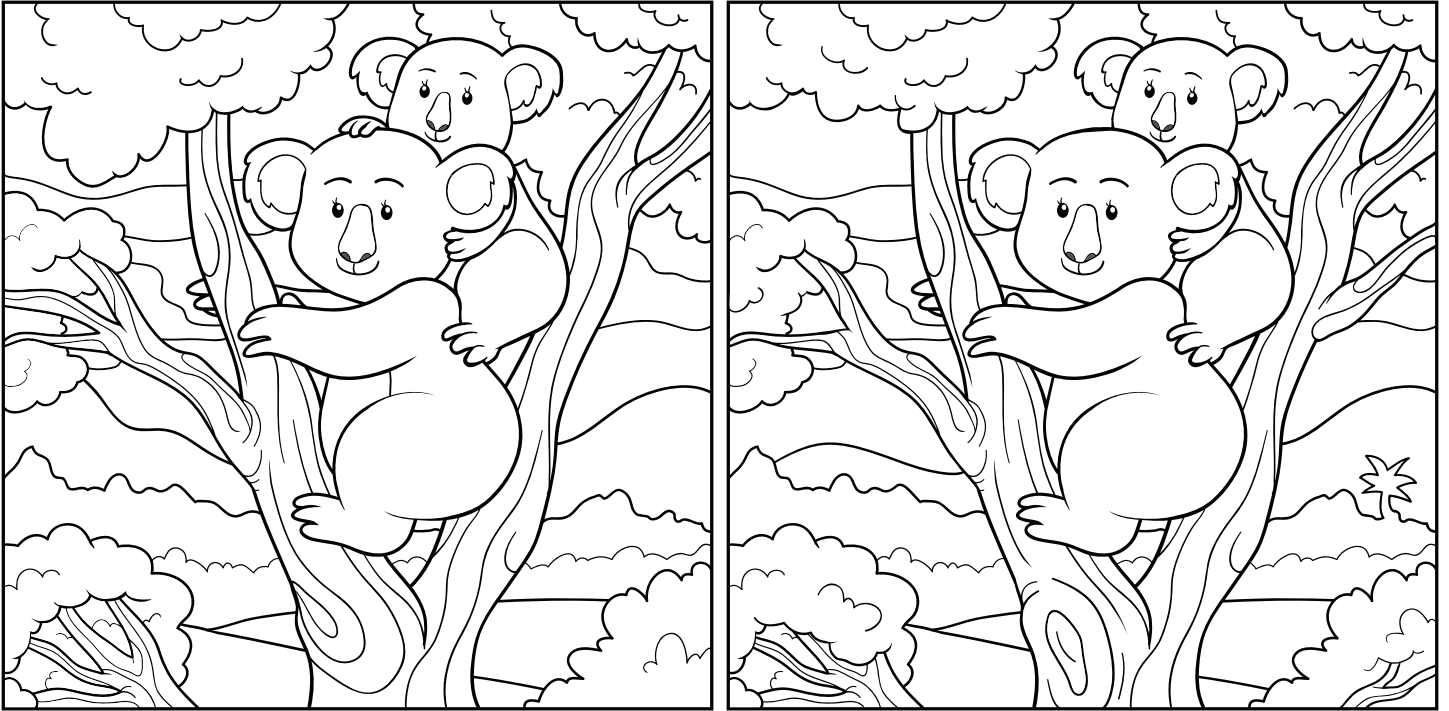
Take your time and see if you can match them all correctly!

Can you find them all?

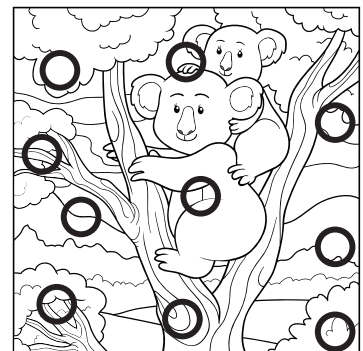


Tips for Playing:

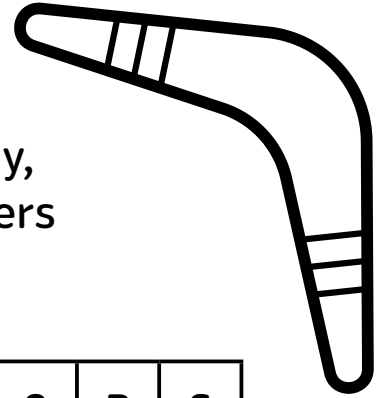
Compare the pictures side-by-side, starting from the top and moving down.
